Reflection & Prayer from "Pope Francis - Living Lent with Love"

What has the Cross given to those who have gazed upon it or touched it? What has it left in each one of us? It gives us a treasure that no one else can give: the certainty of the unshakable love which God has for us. (Meditations on the Stations) Loving God, for love of me, your son, Jesus, put aside everything he might have clung to: power, privilege, prestige. Instead of excusing himself from the pain of life in this world, he met it head-on. He fully inhabited my humanity and refused to absent himself from the worst we humans have to grapple with: anguish, abandonment, betrayal, emotional pain. Could there be any greater love? Amen.

Our readings give us a glimpse into what is required of a disciple: a willingness to speak the words of truth and hope - the Good News of Jesus to others, an ear attuned to the voice of God, sacrifice, patience, faith, trust in the Lord, humility, submission, obedience and a surrendering to God's will. As a disciple of Jesus in which of these characteristics do you excel? In which do you need to be strengthened? As we enter the holiest week of the year, let us take some stewardship of time in prayer to reflect on those questions & on the events of the week. With whom do you most identify: Judas? Peter? The sleeping apostles? Pilate? One who calls for the death of Christ? One of the soldiers mocking Jesus – placing a crown of thorns on his head or who spat upon or hit him? One who drove the nails? One at the foot of the cross watching this horrific death?

Lenten Fasting & Abstinence - Good Friday is a day of fast & abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all between 18 and 59 years old, allowing a person to eat one full meal, two smaller meals, not to equal one full meal with no in-between meal snacks. Abstinence from meat & meat products is obligatory beginning at age 14.
