Lenten Perspective

All through the Gospels, Jesus gives a consistent message urging us to offer mercy and forgiveness to others. We all stumble and fall at times in our lives. It is a sin of pride to believe that how we have offended God through sin is somehow more acceptable than how someone else has offended Him. Follow the example Jesus gave us by converting hearts through mercy, forgiveness and compassion instead of condemnation.

STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS

As stewards of the faith, I'm sure we'd all like to say that we are nothing like the scribes and Pharisees who brought the woman caught in adultery to Jesus. We'd like to think we would never hold the sins of another over them or make ourselves superior to those who are sinners, but if we're honest with ourselves, we know we can't make that claim. By holding their sins over them, we may even be more sinful! It's somehow easier to see the sin of another than it is to see our own; even harder to admit it. The next time we are ready to berate someone, let us remember the words of Jesus, "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone..." Let us seek forgiveness and strive to forgive.

Lenten Season

The 3 pillars of Lent are: prayer, fasting & almsgiving. <u>Prayer</u> – attend daily Mass, make a Holy Hour here or at St. Augustine (doors open during daylight hours, after dark call 330-690-9661), go to confession, make Fridays special by coming to 5:30 pm Mass, stay for private prayer time & then pray the Stations of the Cross at 6:30 pm, pray for fellow parishioners and for the sharing of your stewardship.

<u>Fasting & Abstinence</u> - Good Friday is a day of fasting (for those 60 years old & under) & abstinence. Fridays in Lent are days of complete abstinence from meat & meat products (beginning at age 14).

Lenten Almsgiving - This year we are partnering with John Carroll University to provide clean water filters for Honduras. Collection boxes with a ministry description for which our alms will be used may be found at the main doors of the church. Put in daily change, eat a simple meal & put the money saved into your container; be creative! Almsgiving is one of the three pillars of Lent. We ask you to be generous as you help the people of the Honduras to receive filters that will give them the clean water we take for granted. Spring cleaning? Remember the Free Store. Toiletries for the Peter Maurin Center is ongoing.

<u>Lenten Fridays</u>: 5:30 Mass, prayer time, Stations of the Cross at 6:30 pm. Cross & Candle bearers are needed; you may sign up at the main doors of the church as individuals, a family or as representatives of a ministry.
