## History of Popes

**#128- Pope Marinus II** (*pronounced MAH-rihn-ooce*) - Pope from Oct. 30, 942 – death, May, 946. Marinus, born in Rome was cardinal-priest of the Church of St. Cyriacus, located in the Baths of Diocletian. He was hand-picked by Alberic II, the Roman senator, and as a result wielded little real power or influence. Despite Alberic's watchful eye, Marinus II was able to accomplish some good work while in office. He restored a number of churches in Rome, including several monasteries and was very generous to the poor. Some papal lists confuse Marinus I and II, listing them as "Martinus II" and "Martinus III". As a result of the confusion, the next legitimate "Pope Martin" would go by "Martin IV" to avoid further mix-ups. What else was going on in the world at the time? The great St. Odo of Cluny, the patron saint of rain who oversaw the great monastic reform that healed the Church for centuries, died a month after Marinus II was elected.

Happy birthday, Church! You Do know that the same Spirit that came upon the Apostles at Pentecost is the same Spirit that lives in you, right? We know that when they received the gift of the Holy Spirit the Apostles went out to preach, teach, heal and share the Good News. ### STEWARDSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

**Kenmore Community Meal** - The partnership between I.C. & Park United Methodist has expanded to include a free community meal which will be served in Waldeisen Hall on the last Tuesday of the month from 5 – 6:30 pm. The first meal will be served on June 25<sup>th</sup> and is open to everyone, so come enjoy a free meal and enjoy fellowship with neighbors. **Ways to help:** help in the kitchen (all food will be prepared onsite), be a greeter or a server and help keep costs down by placing requested items in the basket at the front entrance of the church. Requested items: jars of spaghetti sauce, pasta (not spaghetti), Italian or ranch salad dressing, canned chicken, cream of chicken soup, chicken & beef broth or stock, boxes of jello or pudding, cake mixes, canned fruit and veggies, boxes of rice, coffee, powdered creamer, sugar, koolaid and lemonade mixes.
