#### Journey with the Pope

Jesus teaches that it's much the same in the Kingdom of God. Whether you've been a faithful believer working in His vinyard all your life or whether you come in at the last hour; God has grace enough for all and rooms enough for all in heaven! As stewards of the faith, let's seek out those who have fallen away or who don't know Jesus. Let's share our faith stories, listen to their stories, invite them to Mass and to parish events, then encourage and walk with them on their new journeys of faith.
