#### Holy Family Candle - Special Intention

**Lent:** The 3 Pillars of Lent are prayer, fasting & almsgiving. Join us on Fridays to *pray* the *Stations of the Cross* at 5:30 pm. Come and *pray* during *Exposition and Adoration* from 1-2 pm on Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup>. **Fast** and put the savings in your *Rice Bowls* to support Catholic Relief Services. Your *Lenten alms* will serve to help those who literally have nothing. Also at the doors you'll find copies of our *Journey Through Lent* flier.

Fast & Abstinence: Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of complete abstinence from meat and meat products beginning at age 14. Fasting is obligatory for all between the ages of 18 and 59. Fasting allows a person one full meal & two smaller meals, not to equal one full meal; no snacking between meals. Good Friday is a day of obligatory fast.

**Adult Faith Enrichment:** *This* Thursday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7 pm. Topic: Preparing for Sacrifice. Doors open at 6:45 pm. Bring a snack to share.
