Holy Saturday: NOTE CHANGE - We will begin the Vigil at 8:30 pm, not 9 pm as was previously **announced.** Please enter the church in silence.

Inspiration from Henri J. M. Nouwen in The Saving Passion

It was perhaps the peak of Jesus' popularity. A great throng that had gathered for the Passover festival accompanied Him into Jerusalem with shouts of "Hosanna" to the promised Messiah. However, Jesus was headed to Jerusalem not to receive the praise of people, but to receive a crown of thorns. Five days later, another crowd would be shouting "Crucify him!" And their voices prevailed. But through it all, Jesus kept His focus on His mission – to defeat the powers of darkness so we might live in His light forever. As we journey through life toward our final destination, it is tempting to seek the praise, popularity and wealth which this world offers. Following Jesus may mean ridicule and rejection. But what we accomplish for Him and His kingdom will be eternally worthwhile.

STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS

Palm Sunday begins the holiest week of the liturgical calendar. The Sacred Triduum (Three days) begins on Holy Thursday and goes through the Holy Saturday Easter Vigil. As we prepare to enter into this sacred time, let's take with us words from our reading today. St. Paul encourages us to have the attitude of Christ who took the form of a slave by becoming like us and then humbling Himself "obediently accepting even death, death on a cross." How humble are we? How well do we accept the pains and anxieties that mark our days; the crosses we're given to bear? How well do we accept God's will for our lives? Isaiah reminds us that God has given each of us the ability to speak the word of God to those lost and seeking or who just can't find any hope or joy in life. They need to know that God loves them and is waiting for them to come home to Him. Jesus went to the cross for us, all of us, and so as the baptized it's our responsibility to "proclaim to the glory of God the Father: JESUS CHRIST IS LORD!" Invite those who seek to join you and please make every effort to attend Triduum services.
