STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS

Our reading from 1st Corinthians outlines what this Solemnity is all about and it offers a challenge that’s fundamental to our faith, that of handing on the faith from generation to generation. First, Paul says to the community at Corinth: “I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you...” The evangelical spirit is alive and well in Paul; is it within you? Are you handing down to your children and grandchildren the faith given to you by God? Are you working to keep faith alive in your family? Next, Paul lays out the specific teaching from Jesus about the Eucharist which is a basis for our Catholic Faith – that of Real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Do you believe this tenet of our faith? Do you witness to your belief through regular attendance at Mass and reception of Christ’s gift of Himself? The Eucharist is the spiritual food that allows us, as members of the Body of Christ, to offer ourselves up for others and we have many opportunities here at the parish to help you do just that. Pray, reflect, discern and then step forward.
