STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS

Each year, the Diocese of Cleveland publishes a Priest Remuneration and Benefits Package and each parish is obliged to comply. The only part that applies to us now is the section outlining the standard offerings for those who provide extra pastoral assistance (visiting priests). When you have someone remembered at Mass, the cost is \$10.00. It's part of a priest's salary and whether he's visiting or resides at the parish, he receives that amount which is called a stipend; this cost hasn't changed. What has changed is the amount paid to a visiting priest along with mileage. For several years now, visiting priests received \$10 + the stipend for a daily Mass and \$50 + the stipend for a weekend Mass or \$75 + the stipends for 2 weekend Masses; this is what we paid Fr. Mike once he moved out of the rectory. They also received reimbursement for travel in excess of 20 miles one way, if applicable. The **new rate** for weekend Masses which went into effect July 1st is: **\$100.00 + the stipend per** Mass. We're now also responsible for paying roundtrip mileage for each priest regardless of the miles traveled (at the IRS rate). This increase is meant to put our diocese into a more equitable situation compared to other dioceses around the country, but it obviously puts a much greater burden on our already difficult financial situation. This along with our monthly assessments plus utilities, staff pay, insurance, property tax, etc. will stretch us to the limit. Please be good stewards by using your envelopes. If you visit another parish on the weekend, please mail or drop off your parish envelopes here. If you go on vacation, please be sure to put aside money for our parish before you leave; that's what I'll be doing while I'm away. Many sacrificed so that we would have this parish. Let's make sure we do the same for future generations. Thank you. Melissa
