STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS

You may wonder why we have a feast for the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. This church, located in Rome, was dedicated to the Savior by Pope St. Sylvester on November 9, A.D. 324 and is considered the “Mother and Head” of all the churches in the world. Each year, on November 9th, the universal Church remembers and celebrates Lateran’s dedication. The Catholic Encyclopedia tells us that in 324, it was considered the special church of the Bishop of Rome (the Pope) and was known as well as the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome. It saw some restoration in the early 10th century and was also dedicated to St. John the Baptist so is known as “St. John Lateran”. This special place housed the four Lateran ecumenical councils between 1123 and 1215 and has certainly seen much history over the years. The present basilica and the palace next door date from the 14th century. Masses are still celebrated regularly throughout the day and is also open for tours. Now you know!

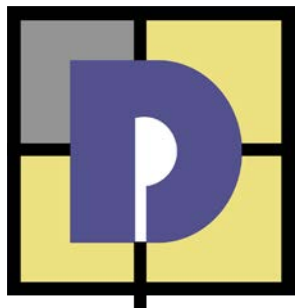
